## WHAT WE ARE WORKING ON

**Math:** We will be learning about measurement, using nonstandard units of measurements (ex: string, paper clips, etc.) We will be using the terms longer, shorter, taller, heavier and lighter.

**Writing:** We have been starting to write simple sentences, using capital letters in the beginning and ending with a period.

**Reading:** We will be reading *The Recess Queen*, we will be answering questions about this book and retelling the story. You can practice at home by reading stories with your child and asking them questions about the text.

**Science/Social Studies:** We will be working on what it means to be a good friend, classmate and student.
